He will go over a brief history of where and how the disease emerged, what the symptoms look like on high-risk hosts and strategies for keeping Virginia nurseries free of this disease. 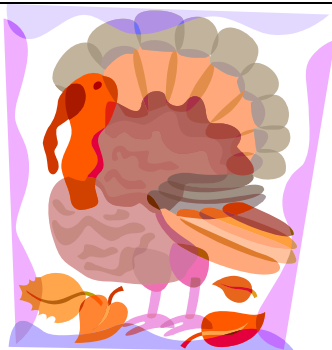
